Welcome To Third Grade!

Greetings from your teachers! We are looking forward to many special and exciting experiences with your child. They will be challenged in many ways.

In Math, we are using the Go Math series which has a strong emphasis on problem solving in word problem form. We regularly review our basic facts in addition and subtraction, and then quickly progress to renaming with larger digits. Throughout the year we will study a variety of topics: place value, measurement, multiplication, division, geometry, and fractions.

Your student will receive instruction in the literature-based MacMillian McGraw Hill Reading Series on the Third Grade level. Writing will be done daily to incorporate a variety of skills across the curriculum.

Trips will be taken from the bottom of the sea to the farthest planet and around the globe, learning about communities. (We'll also take some field trips in the Delaware Valley.)

The Homework Assignment Book (HAB) will be sent home daily for you to check assignments and sign when they are complete. Please be sure to review it with your child and sign the contract in the front of the book. The HAB is a source of communication between parent, child and teachers and helps develop organizational skills. We suggest that you and your child plan a certain time each day to review homework and sign the book when the work is completed.

The following supplies will be needed for each student: a 2 boxes of 12 pencils (to be replenished frequently throughout the year), crayons (no larger than 24), 2 glue sticks, a pair of scissors, eraser caps for pencil tops, a zipper pouch pencil case only, three composition notebooks, and a total of 6 folders (red, blue, yellow, green, and 3 free choice), 1 highlighter (your choice of color), 1 dry erase marker, and a clean sock or eraser (for dry erase boards). Student desks are not large enough to accommodate 3 ring binders or plastic style pencil cases, so students are asked not to bring them to school.

Open House will be held during the first few weeks of school in September to answer any additional questions about the Third Grade program.
