We are pleased to welcome you back for the 2022-2023 school year.

During the 2022-2023 school year, the USDA will no longer be providing free meals to all students. A school lunch will be available for purchase. The monthly lunch menu is posted on the district website and can be viewed by clicking on this [link](#). The cost for a school lunch is \$3.50 and includes milk. Milk, juice, and snacks can also be purchased and are listed on the lunch menu. You may use MySchoolBucks to make payments or send cash or check in an envelope for the cafeteria to deposit in your child's account. Each student will be provided a lunch ID number to use while coming through the cafeteria serving line.

The MySchoolBucks website will allow you to manage your child's account online and track what your child purchased. Please visit [MySchoolBucks.com](https://www.myschoolbucks.com) for more information on setting up and using MySchoolBucks.

Your child may qualify for free lunch through the USDA if you meet certain eligibility requirements. Income requirements have changed so please review the *Free & Reduced Letter & FAQs*.
