## **Activities to Do Together**

### Vocabulary

Ask your child to use at least four of the **Target Vocabulary** words to describe a rainy day.

#### Go Team!

What role does teamwork play in the your family's daily routine? Talk with your child about how each member of your family helps other family members.

#### **Write About Teamwork**
