## COMING THIS WEEK...

In Fundations this week, we will practice lowercase formations and sounds for the skyline letters **I**, **h**, **and k** (review t, b, f, m, n, i, c, o, a, g, u, d, s, e, r, p, and j). Students should be able to match letters to sounds for letters learned so far such as identifying the beginning sounds of a word and writing that letter. We will begin to notice ending sounds of words as well. In Journeys' this week we will explore the theme of "Animal Movements - Why do animals move in different ways?" We will be learning the sight words "**a**" and "**little**".. When we read this week, we will focus on details, sequencing, and comparing and contrasting characters and ideas in the stories. We will work on adjectives and color words to describe things. This week in writing, they will begin working on their chosen topic for lists and labels. When we label at this point in the year, we use beginning sounds and resources to write words. Students can begin to use sight words to build a phrase or sentence. We are also continuing to practice staying on topic, clear details in pictures, and 5-star coloring.

Unit 2 sight words: see, play, we, have, a, little

Target skills: details, comparing characters/ideas, and asking and answering questions while reading. We will also continue recognizing and producing rhyming pairs, counting syllables in words, summarize stories, writing ideas with pictures/labels, concepts of print, adjectives, letters, pencil grip, writing grid

#### Math

We will wrap up Chapter 4 this week which works with the number 10 and comparing all numbers within 10. We will model, count, and write 10. We will compare numbers within 10, sequence to 10, and find ways to make 10. Students will learn the "Friends of 10" 10 and 0, 9 and 1, 8 and 2, 7 and 3, 6 and 4, 5 and 5.

We will be assessing Chapter 4 skills on Tuesday 12/03. Practice with the review packet.

We will begin Chapter 5 this week introducing addition.

## TIPS AND TRICKS

- Each night recite the alphabet, practice counting to 20 or above, write name starting with a capital letter
- Optional: Sight word box. Each week when we learn new words, add them to a box and pick out a few each night to practice. (shoe box, wipes container, index cards). Ask students to come up with rhyming words as well.
- Password Game: Choose different letters, numbers, and sight words to make as "passwords" to different rooms in the house. Every time the students want to enter the room, ask for the password:-)
- Sight word walk spread sight word cards out in a path and see how far you can get without missing any.
