### COMING THIS WEEK...

#### Literacy

v - "van" - /v/ w - "wind" - /w/

In Fundations this week, we are learning the letter formation and sounds for **v** and **w** (plain line slide letters). We will review, t, b, f, m, n, i, c, o, a, g, d, s, r, e, p, j, l, h, k and u. We will focus on 'ending' sounds this week. We also will be using sentence frames to practice spacing, punctuation, and capitals, In Journeys', we will be exploring the theme of **'Wheels''**. We will review reading strategies. We will use adjectives to describe things using color and number words. We will add sight words: **to** and **look.** We will review skills such as action verbs, nouns, synonyms, and beginning sounds as well as starting to blend separate sounds together to make words. The 'onset' is the initial sound and the 'rime' is the string of letters to follow (Blend /c/ - /at/ for cat). When we read this week, we will focus on retelling key details in order, summarizing, and understanding characters. In reading groups, we will continue to practice decoding with picture clues and beginning and ending sounds. This week in writing, we will be working on their chosen topic for lists and labels. When we label at this point in the year, we use beginning sounds, sight words, color and number words, and resources to write words. Students can begin to use sight words to build a phrase or sentence. We are also continuing to practice staying on topic, clear details in pictures, and 5-star coloring.

#### Unit 2 sight words: see, play, we, have, a, little, to, look

<u>Target skills</u>: details, conclusions, and asking and answering questions while reading ("wh" questions). We will also continue recognizing and producing rhyming pairs, counting syllables in words, writing ideas with pictures/labels, concepts of print, adjectives (number words), letters v and w, pencil grip, writing grid

#### Math

We will begin Chapter 5 this week introducing addition. This chapter focuses on understanding **addition** as putting together or "adding to". We will use the 'plus' sign symbol to record addition. We will use pictures to and 10-frames to model groups and solve addition problems. We will listen to addition problems and draw or modell to solve as well. Please practice chapter 5 vocabulary terms that were sent home last week: add, put together, plus sign, sum, altogether.

TIPS AND TRICKS

- Each night recite the alphabet, practice counting to 20 or above, write name starting with a capital letter, create rhyming pairs, practice "Friends of 10"
- Optional: Sight word box. Each week when we learn new words, add them to a box and pick out a few each night to practice. (shoe box, wipes container, index cards). Ask students to come up with rhyming words as well.
- Password Game: Choose different letters, numbers, and sight words to make as "passwords" to different rooms in the house. Every time the students want to enter the room, ask for the password :-)
- Sight word walk spread sight word cards out in a path and see how far you can get without missing any.
- Visit Mrs. Gray's website for additional practice sites categorized by content area. You can find her page in the "staff directory" on the District Website.

- Use Uno cards 1-9 (2 of each number). Flip them over spread out in the form of "memory". Flip 2 cards and see if they are a "friend of 10". If not, flip back over. If they are a friend of 10, player keeps the pairs
- Give your child 3 words. 2 words should start with the same sound while one does not. Students will identify the word that does not start the same. Example: two, taco, ball
- Counting syllables in words
