## COMING THIS WEEK...

Literacy

In Fundations this week, we will be continuing to practice lowercase formations and sounds for the letters **d** and **s** (review t, b, f, m, n, i, c, o, a, g and u). Students should be able to match letters to sounds for letters learned so far such as identifying the beginning sounds of a word and writing that letter. Lowercase d and s both start on the plane line. Students are recognizing the differences between b and d when writing and identifying their sounds. In Journeys', we will continue to explore fairy tales for review of unit 1 skills. We will be working with skills such as action verbs, nouns, synonyms, and recognizing beginning sounds. We will be reviewing all of unit 1 sight words. In addition, we will be able to compare text features, characters, settings, and sequencing important parts. In writing, we will continue our unit for "lists and labels". Students are working on creating pictures with clear details and "5-star" coloring with the addition of putting them in order this week! Students will be encouraged to add labels with the beginning sounds that we have learned so far.

Unit 1 sight words: I, one, like, our, day, the, and, off

\*Students will be assessed on unit 1 skills and words this week. This is a check-in on skills that continue to develop throughout the year. For example, answering questions about a story read aloud to them, producing rhyming words, identifying beginning sounds, and reading sight words.

Target skills: details, comparing characters, understanding characters, and asking questions while reading. We will also continue recognizing and producing rhyming pairs, summarize stories, writing ideas with pictures/labels, concepts of print, action verbs, letters a and g, pencil grip, writing grid, reading stamina with picture walks using the "eagle eye" strategy.

### Math

We will finish up Chapter 3 this week on numbers 6-9. We will practice counting, recognizing, showing, and writing each number. The end of this chapter will also give practice with problem solving as well as review greater than and less than strategies when we compare numbers 1-9. Students are practicing making these numbers in different ways with number pairs. For example: 7 is 6 and 1 more or 5 and 2 more. We do this activity with 2 color counters as a visual. Practice vocabulary.

\*We plan to assess Chapter 3 on Wednesday\* Please use chapter 3 review packet to practice throughout the week.
