Dear East Greenwich Families,

I hope you're finding time to relax and enjoy these sunny summer days. In September, we look forward to full days of in-person instruction for all students. Our school day will begin at 8:40am and end at 3:20pm. Student drop off is from 8:25am-8:40am and student pick up is from 3:20pm-3:30pm. Students will have lunch and recess daily, and special areas will return to in-person classes. Our principals are busy planning for the new school year, and they will provide more information to families later in the summer.

Health and safety protocols will continue during the 2021-2022 school year. They will be guided by the New Jersey Department of Health Guidance for Schools and the New Jersey Department of Education's <u>The Road Forward: Health and Safety Guidance for the 2021-2022 School Year</u>. This document provides school districts with recommendations, rather than requirements, for mitigating the spread of COVID-19. *The Road Forward* clearly indicates that districts can expect more guidance later this summer. Once we receive the final guidance, we will update families.

Due to the expiration of Executive Order 175, mask-wearing is optional for staff and students during summer programming. Mask-wearing will <u>continue to be optional on campus</u> unless there is an executive order requiring masks or a significant change in local health conditions. Due to a federal order, masks continue to be required on buses.

The New Jersey Department of Health and the Centers for Disease Control continue to strongly recommend mask-wearing for non-vaccinated individuals. Please consider providing your input on this one question survey about mask-wearing. Click <u>here</u> to complete it by Wednesday, July 21st.

Our district will receive federal funds through the American Rescue Plan for a safe return to school, so we must publish our health and safety protocols in a "Safe Return Plan". The first draft of the plan was approved by our board of education in June, but the plan will <u>continue to be updated</u> throughout the summer months. Revisions will be based upon NJDOH and NJDOE guidance.
