#### 2025-2026 Calendar

Our **2025-2026** school year calendar was approved at last night's board meeting, and it can be found <u>here</u>. Please note we are adjusting the timing of our parent-teacher conferences to better support student success. Conferences will be held during the last week of October, rather than the traditional pre-Thanksgiving schedule. This change places conferences at mid-trimester, providing several benefits:

- Teachers can share meaningful progress updates about your student's performance
- Families will have sufficient time to implement suggested strategies and supports
- Students will have opportunities to demonstrate growth before trimester grades close

## iReady Math Transition Back to Traditional Grading Scale

We are pleased to share an update regarding our math grading practices for Trimester 2 and the successful implementation of iReady Math. After careful analysis of our students' progress during Trimester 1, we will return to our traditional A-F grading scale for mathematics in Trimester 2. This decision is supported by impressive data from our first trimester.

Our comparative analysis of math grades between 2023 and 2024 shows that student performance in first through fifth grades has remained consistently strong, with grades varying by only 1-2 points from the previous year. This demonstrates that our students have successfully adapted to iReady Math's inquiry-based, student-centered approach.

We are proud of our students' resilience and engagement with this new mathematics curriculum, and we look forward to building on this success in Trimester 2.
