COVID Exclusion Reasons

Please keep your child home from school if:

- Your child has 2 or more of the following symptoms: Fever, chills or shivers, myalgia (muscle aches), headache, sore throat, nausea or vomiting, diarrhea, fatigue, congestion or runny nose
- Your child has 1 of the following symptoms: cough, shortness of breath, difficulty breathing or new loss of taste or smell
- Your child has close contact with a person with COVID-19
- Someone in your household is being tested for COVID-19 or is diagnosed with COVID-19
- Your child has traveled to any state on the travel advisory

Daily Symptom Screening

Please complete the Daily Symptom Screening form for each day of in-person learning. The Google form is due by 7:30am for each student attending in -person learning. We appreciate your continued cooperation.

Face Masks

Students: Students must wear a clean, well-fitted face mask. Gaiters and valved masks are no longer permitted based upon the Department of Health guidance. If your child does not have a mask, or if his or her mask becomes soiled or wet throughout the day, we have disposable masks available for your child.

Hand Hygiene

Hand hygiene includes washing with soap and water for at least 20 seconds or using hand sanitizer that contains at least 60% alcohol. (Students age 5 and under will use hand sanitizer only when monitored by an adult.) Please review hand hygiene habits with your students. Hand hygiene will take place upon arriving at school, after using the bathroom, before/after eating snack, after coughing, after sneezing, after blowing one's nose and prior to leaving for dismissal. Hand sanitizing stations are located in all classrooms and at entrance/exit points.

Illness at School

The Southwest Region remains in the High Risk category (orange), and that designation has **a significant impact** on the designation of a close contact and quarantine requirements. In the High Risk category, a close contact is **also** an individual who was within 6 feet of an individual with **COVID-like symptoms** for 15 cumulative minutes or more in a 24-hour period. For this reason, we ask that you keep your student home if he or she is ill.



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An individual who develops COVID-19 symptoms while at school will be isolated in the isolation room. The school nurse will conduct contacting tracing and send the individual home. The areas used by the individual will be closed off for 24 hours prior to cleaning. Administration will contact the other students' families to make them aware of the relocation due to COVID-like symptoms. After 24 hours, the room will be cleaned, disinfected and reopened.
