Arrival Information

On the first day of school, please send your student with their name tag. This will help students get to where they need to report to as smoothly as possible!

Parent Drop-Off/Non-Transported: Students may not enter the building until 8:25am. Please remain with your student until 8:25am to ensure proper supervision from staff members on duty. If you are driving, students must exit from the passenger side after the vehicle has pulled forward to the first grade parent drop-off entrance. Students will be guided to their homerooms by staff members on duty within the building.

<u>Bus Students:</u> Buses will pull into the bus lanes. Clark students will be designated to exit the bus and staff members on duty with guide students to their homerooms.

Beginner students will meet with their teacher or aide in the gym and cafeteria for the first few weeks of school to practice walking to their classrooms.

Preschool students will be met by their teachers and instructional aides at the preschool entrance along the front of the building.







Snack and Lunch Information

Our school district is maintaining a peanut/tree nut-free classroom environment. Please do not send any tree nuts, peanuts, peanut butter, or foods containing tree nuts or peanuts or nut butters to be eaten as snacks in the classroom.

School lunches are available for purchase from the cafeteria. The cost is \$3.50 per student. School lunch includes the daily entrée, assorted fruit and/or vegetable, 1% milk and/or juice. Bottled water can be purchased separately, \$1 for a 16.9 oz bottle or \$.70 for an 8 oz bottle. Milk can be purchased for \$.60. Snacks are also available each day ranging from \$.80 to \$1.25. Prices are subject to change.

Bus Students: Students will be dismissed from their homerooms and will be walked down to the Clark Gym. The teacher assigned to supervise the bus will escort the students to their bus to ensure they load safely on the bus.
