
Students will create a special classroom handshake or greeting. Students, parents and staff will understand the short-term and long-term benefits of social emotional learning.

Smartwatch Reminder

Smartwatches are permitted District-wide; however they should be used exclusively for time-telling.

When Smartwatches are used with any other purpose besides a watch, the device will be treated as a violation of acceptable use.

If an electronic device is discovered, the following will apply:

- 1st Offense: Staff member confiscates the electronic device with a warning and gives the student back the device at the end of the school day.
- 2.2nd Offense: Staff member confiscates the device, sends it to the main office, and the student may come to the office at the end of the day to bring it home.

3rd Offense: Same as above, but the parent must pick up the electronic device from the main office.
