- THE CHILD ASSAULT PREVENTION (CAP) PROJECT OFFERS A COMPREHENSIVE APPROACH TO THE PROBLEM OF BULLYING IN SCHOOLS. "CAP'S BULLYING PREVENTION PROGRAM" IS AN INNOVATIVE PROGRAM DESIGNED FOR KINDERGARTEN TO 8TH GRADE AND IS TO BE IMPLEMENTED IN SCHOOLS THAT HAVE ALREADY HAD THE CHILD ASSAULT PREVENTION PROGRAM.
- WITH THE HELP OF OUR HOME AND SCHOOL ASSOCIATION, THE JEFFREY CLARK SCHOOL HAS BEEN SELECTED THROUGH A GRANT TO RECEIVE THE NJ CAP BULLYING PREVENTION WORKSHOP FOR OUR FIRST AND SECOND GRADE STUDENTS. THIS TWO-DAY 90 MINUTE INTERACTIVE WORKSHOP.

Fun Fact: Read Across America first began in 1997. The event's goal was to promote reading among children. The dates originally coincided with Dr. Seuss' birthday on March 2! READ ACROSS AMERICA AND NATIONAL READING MONTH BEGINS ON MARCH 3RD. TO CELEBRATE WE WILL ONCE AGAIN HAVE FUN ACTIVITIES THE FIRST WEEK OF MARCH AND A MONTH-LONG READING CHALLENGE. PLEASE REFERENCE TO FLYER TO THE LEFT FOR EACH DAY'S THEME. THERE ARE TWO SPIRIT DAYS ON MARCH 4TH (HAT DAY) AND MARCH 5TH (SPORTS ATTIRE DAY).

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THERE IS A <u>READING CHALLENGE FOR PRE-K</u> AND A <u>READING RACE FOR B-2</u> (PAPER COPIES HAVE BEEN DISTRIBUTED TO EVERY STUDENT PRIOR TO MARCH 1ST TO ENCOURAGE DAILY READING).

STUDENTS WILL FILL OUT THEIR READING MINUTES FOR EACH DAY THEY READ ON THE CALENDAR AND TOTAL THEIR MINUTES AT THE END OF THE MONTH. ALL LOGS ARE DUE BACK BY FRIDAY, APRIL 4.

FOR B-2, THE HOMEROOM IN EACH GRADE LEVEL THAT READS THE MOST MINUTES WILL WIN A PRIZE. ADDITIONALLY, ON THE REVERSE SIDE OF THE B-2 LOG, THERE IS A BONUS CHALLENGE FOR STUDENTS TO READ BOOKS FEATURING DIFFERENT THEMES/SUBJECTS/GENRES. STUDENTS WHO RETURN THEIR LOG WITH AT LEAST THREE DIFFERENT TYPES OF BOOKS CIRCLED ARE ENTERED INTO A PRIZE DRAWING.

WE ARE PREPARING TO FILL OUR OPEN SEATS FOR THE 2025-2026 SCHOOL YEAR WITH A LOTTERY. TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR THE LOTTERY, STUDENTS MUST BE 3 OR 4 YEARS OLD AS OF OCTOBER 1, 2025, RESIDE IN EAST GREENWICH AND BE UP TO DATE ON IMMUNIZATIONS. THE CLASSROOMS WILL BE MIXED AGE WITH THREE AND FOUR YEAR OLDS IN THE SAME ROOM. APPROXIMATELY 70% OF OUR SEATS WILL BE RESERVED FOR FOUR YEAR OLDS, AND 30% WILL BE RESERVED FOR THREE YEAR OLDS. STUDENTS ARE EXPECTED TO ATTEND THE PROGRAM FIVE FULL DAYS PER WEEK, AND TRANSPORTATION IS PROVIDED TO ELIGIBLE PRESCHOOL STUDENTS. PLEASE NOTE:

- STUDENTS WHO TURN 5 YEARS OLD ON OR BEFORE OCTOBER 1, 2025 ARE NOT ELIGIBLE FOR PRESCHOOL. THEY
 ARE ELIGIBLE FOR BEGINNERS.
- STUDENTS CURRENTLY ENROLLED IN THE PRESCHOOL PROGRAM DO NOT NEED TO PARTICIPATE IN THE LOTTERY.
- THIS IS A NEW LOTTERY FOR THE 2025-2026 SCHOOL YEAR. LOTTERY RESULTS FROM 2024-2025 ARE NOT VALID FOR THE 2025-2026 SCHOOL YEAR.

TO BE CONSIDERED FOR THE PRESCHOOL LOTTERY, PLEASE COMPLETE THE <u>2025-2026 PRESCHOOL LOTTERY</u> <u>APPLICATION</u> BY MONDAY, MARCH 17TH AT 10:00AM. LATE APPLICATIONS WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED. ONCE REGISTERED IN THE LOTTERY, YOU WILL RECEIVE AN EMAIL WITH A LOTTERY NUMBER AND DIRECTIONS TO ACCESS THE LIVE, VIRTUAL LOTTERY BY MARCH 19TH.

THE LOTTERY WILL BE HELD ON THURSDAY, MARCH 20TH AT 10:00AM. ALL PARENTS WHO SUBMITTED PRESCHOOL LOTTERY APPLICATIONS WILL BE NOTIFIED OF LOTTERY RESULTS BY MONDAY, MARCH 24TH. IF YOUR CHILD WAS SELECTED VIA THE LOTTERY, WE WILL INITIATE THE REGISTRATION PROCESS. PLEASE CLICK <u>HERE</u> FOR REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS.
