## **Board of Education Vacancy**

The East Greenwich Township Board of Education is seeking applicants to fill a vacancy for a term which ends in January 2026. To qualify, you must be a citizen and resident of the district, and shall have been such for at least one year immediately preceding your appointment, must be able to read and write, must be registered to vote in the district, and must not be disqualified as a voter pursuant to N.J.S.A. 19:4-1.

If you are interested, please submit a letter of interest and resume via email to Mr. Greg Wilson, School Business Administrator at <u>wilsong@eastgreenwich.k12.nj.us</u>. Your application must be received by **Friday, March 14, 2025**. The selection will be made by majority vote of the remaining members of the Board of Education.
