School Meal Information

Please find the Food Services welcome letter <u>here</u>. School lunch will be served daily in the cafeteria on full session days. The cost for a student lunch is \$3.50. It includes an entrée, fruit and/or vegetable and milk and/or juice. Milk, juice, bottled water and a variety of snacks are available for purchase daily.

Students will have the opportunity to order lunch each morning, and a monthly menu will be posted on the district website and sent home on the back of each school's monthly paper calendar. The Free & Reduced Price Meal Plan Application may be completed by anyone who thinks they may qualify. The salary threshold has been decreased, and you may now qualify this year when you have been denied in previous years. The **2025-2026 application has not yet been released**. 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Transportation Information

Please review the transportation updates below from Mrs. Ann Marie Elliott, Transportation Coordinator. Mrs. Elliott can be reached at elliotta@eastgreenwich.k12.nj.us.

- Bus passes will be mailed by the end of next week for fully registered students in preschool through grade 6. Please be sure to review your child's bus pass closely. <u>Bus numbers,</u> routes and stops may have changed. These changes are due to changing student populations in some neighborhoods.
- Jeffrey Clark students must have a parent/guardian or Samuel Mickle sibling at the bus stop with them at pick up and drop off.
- Pick up and drop off times are approximate. Please be sure to have your child ready to board the bus 10 minutes prior to the scheduled pick-up time. After a week or two, the pick-up time will be consistent because the routine will be familiar to all.
- Please expect bus delays the first week of school for students. As students learn the new routine, it may take longer to board the bus, find seats and buckle seatbelts. Our drivers are also learning new routes and helping students. Once all are familiar with the routines, these types of delays will subside.
- If there will be a significant delay in either pick up or drop off, it will be communicated to you via text message as soon as our contractor advises the district.
