Read Across America is almost here! To celebrate Read Across America in conjunction with National Reading Month, once again we will have a month-long reading challenge starting on March 1, 2025.

We created a Reading Calendar ([2025 Samuel Mickle RAA Reading Calendar](#)) and paper copies will be distributed to every student prior to March 1st to encourage daily reading. They will fill out their reading minutes each day on the calendar and total their minutes at the end of the month. Please add your initials to their passport before your child turns it into their homeroom teacher on Wednesday, April 2nd. The homeroom and individual student in each grade level that reads the most minutes will win a prize.

We also created a digital flyer ([2025 Samuel Mickle Read Across America](#)) that has our two dress up days on Tuesday, March 4th (*hat day*) and Wednesday, March 5th (*favorite team/sports or school spirit wear*).
