During the Special Areas, Related Services, and School Community Tables session, you may choose to visit your child's Special Areas, Speech & Language, and Basic Skills teachers, as well as other staff such as the Child Study Team members, school nurse, and school counselor. These staff members will be available in their classrooms/offices. During the homeroom classroom presentations, 5th and 6th grade homeroom teachers will provide parents with a rotation schedule so you are able to meet each of your child's teachers.

A Few Important Notes:

- Due to limited spacing, this will be a parent-only event and we kindly ask that children not attend.
- When the main parking lot is full, please utilize the Jeffrey Clark School parking lot and the overflow parking. Officers will be available to direct traffic and assist.
- Classroom presentations are intended to provide an opportunity to meet your child's teacher and learn information regarding your child's instructional programming. In grades 3 and 4, two homeroom classroom sessions rotations will be held in order for you to select the session of your choice.
- Special Area teachers and Related Services staff will be available in their classrooms/offices in an "open house" format during session times. School Community groups will be available at tables located in the cafeteria.
