Dear Parents and Guardians:

In spring 2023, students in grades 3-6 participated in the NJSLA (New Jersey Student Learning Assessments), which measure their academic performance in ELA, Math, and Science (grade 5 only). The results from statewide testing are one of the many valuable tools used to measure a child's success in school.

During the week of October 9, 2023, if you have a child who took the NJSLA, you will receive via mail a report with your child's ISR (Individual Score Report). The report will show your child's performance on each section of the NJSLA, charts and graphics that show how your child performed in relation to the New Jersey State Learning Standards, and how your child's performance compares to other students in our school, our district, and the state.

ISRs are also available via the New Jersey Parent Portal. This portal includes your child's scale score, level of performance, and video explanations for the score reports. Also on the portal is a copy of the Parent Score Interpretation Guide. The portal also allows you to track your child's scores from year to year, beginning with Spring 2019. You can create an account using the claim code on your child's ISR.
