Dear Parents and Guardians,

In this envelope, you will find a home instruction work packet for your child to complete in the event of a school closure. Your child's home instruction packet was developed by his/ her teacher to meet the student's specific needs and therefore may have variations from the grade level work packets posted on the school website.

The work contained in this packet is intended to cover 10 days of academic activities. Each day's assignment should take approximately two hours to complete for elementary students and approximately one hour for preschool students. Your child should plan to complete 1/10 of the packet each day. Daily assignments contain work for English Language Arts, math and Science/Social Studies. In the back of the packet you will find tasks and activities aligned to special areas classes including physical education, music, art, Spanish, and music instruction.

The work in this packet is intended to be a review of previously taught class lessons. While some of this work may be able to be completed independently, we ask that you please support your child in learning by reading directions, answering clarifying questions, or providing help as needed. Some of the activities will be pencil/paper while others may be task oriented (ex. - count to a given number, do a certain number of jumping jacks). Technology resources may also be included as optional tasks for students who have access to technology and who may want additional practice with skills.

Classroom teachers will be communicating daily through the Dojo App and/or email. Should you or your child have any questions or concerns regarding the work packet, please feel free to reach out to your child's teacher through the Dojo App or by email.

Once school resumes, we ask that you return only the completion form titled "Home Instruction Work Packet". Please provide feedback, sign and date this document indicating that your child completed the assigned work.
