**ROLL CALL**

Roll call was taken with the following members present: Back, Hicks, Jones, Licciardello, Marino, McGravey, Nevius, Schonewise, and Skowronski. Also present were the Superintendent, the Business Administrator/Board Secretary, and eight (8) members of the public.

On motion by Licciardello, second by Marino, and carried by unanimous voice vote, the Board adopted all the existing policies and bylaws of the Board of Education until revised.
