RESOLUTION TO RENEW
SCHOOLS HEALTH INSURANCE FUND

WHEREAS, a number of school boards in the State of New Jersey have joined together to form the **SCHOOLS HEALTH INSURANCE FUND** hereafter referred to as "SHIF", as permitted N.J.S.A. 18A:18B-1 et seq., and;

WHEREAS, the SHIF has received approval by the Commissioner of the Department of Banking and Insurance on August 10, 2015;

WHEREAS, the statutes and regulations governing the creation and operation of a joint insurance fund, contain certain elaborate restrictions and safeguards concerning the safe and efficient administration of the public interest entrusted to such a school board joint insurance fund;

WHEREAS, the governing body of East Greenwich Township Board of Education, hereinafter referred to as "SCHOOL BOARD" has determined that membership in the SHIF is in the best interest of said SCHOOL BOARD.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the governing body of the SCHOOL BOARD hereby agrees as follows:

- i. SCHOOL BOARD shall become a member of the SHIF for the period outlined in the SCHOOL BOARD's Indemnity and Trust Agreement.
- ii. SCHOOL BOARD will participate in the following type (s) of coverage (s):
 - a.) Health Insurance as defined pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17B:17-4, the SHIF's Bylaws, and the SHIF's Plan of Risk Management.
- iii. SCHOOL BOARD accepts and approves the SHIF's Bylaws and agrees to be bound by the terms thereof.
- iv. SCHOOL BOARD shall execute an application for membership and any accompanying certifications.
- v. SCHOOL BOARD agrees to commit to the four principles of the SHIF which are:
 - a.) A long term philosophy on rates.
 - b.) A willingness to work with bargaining units to achieve plan design changes.
 - c.) Professional management with stability and commitment.
 - d.) Rating structure based on actuarial numbers.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the governing body of the SCHOOL BOARD is authorized and directed to execute the Indemnity and Trust Agreement and such other documents signifying membership in the SHIF as required by the SHIF's Bylaws, and to deliver these documents to the SHIF's Executive Director with the express reservation that these documents shall become effective only upon:

- i. Approval of the SCHOOL BOARD by the SHIF.
- ii. Receipt by the SHIF of a Resolution from the SCHOOL BOARD accepting SCHOOL BOARD's SHIF assessment.
- iii. Approval by the Commissioner of the New Jersey Department of Banking and Insurance of SCHOOL BOARD as a member of the SHIF.

**Resolution Directing the Distribution of the
East Greenwich Township School District
Net Returned Surplus Funds Held in Trust by the
GLOUCESTER, CUMBERLAND, SALEM SCHOOL DISTRICTS JIF**

WHEREAS, the East Greenwich Township School District, hereinafter referred to as BOARD, participated as a member district of the Gloucester, Cumberland, Salem School Districts JIF, hereinafter referred to as FUND, for the FUND fiscal year beginning July 1, 2016, **and**

WHEREAS, the FUND is a statutory filed school district joint insurance fund as defined in N.J.S.A. 18A:18B1-10 et seq., **and**
WHEREAS, the BOARD joined the FUND knowing that membership carries with it joint and several liability with all other member districts for each year of the BOARD's membership, **and**

WHEREAS, the BOARD understands that the FUND's Board of Trustees are the only persons authorized in law to make decisions as to when and how much of any available statutory surplus will be released by the FUND, **and**

WHEREAS, the BOARD understands that the FUND's Board of Trustees are the only persons authorized in law to make decisions as to when and how much of any projected deficit will be declared as an additional assessment due to the FUND, **and**

WHEREAS, the BOARD understands that Available Statutory Surplus is defined to be the amount of money in excess of the projected value of claims by line of coverage, plus an actuarially determined value for Incurred But Not Reported claims, subject to the surplus reserve calculations as defined in N.J.A.C. 11:15-4.6 et seq., and subject to review and approval by the Department of Banking and Insurance, State of New Jersey, prior to release by the Board of Trustees of the FUND, **and**

WHEREAS, the BOARD understands that it remains jointly and severally liable into perpetuity despite the earlier release of Available Statutory Surplus due to the possibility that a FUND year wherein a return of Statutory Surplus has been duly authorized could later be presented with a claim for which it could be responsible causing a demand for an additional assessment from each participating member district of that FUND year, **and**

WHEREAS, the BOARD understands that it remains jointly and severally liable into perpetuity despite the earlier collection of an additional assessment due to the possibility that a FUND year wherein an additional assessment has been duly authorized could later be presented with a need for additional assessments from each participating member district of that FUND year, **and**

WHEREAS, the BOARD recognizes its Share of Available Statutory Surplus authorized to be released by the FUND is as shown below:

WHEREAS, the BOARD understands that its options for directing the distribution of its net share of released Statutory Surplus to be as follows:

1. Direct the FUND to forward a check for the BOARD's full share to the BOARD,
2. Direct the FUND to apply the BOARD's share to the BOARD's 2020-2021 premium in the FUND fiscal year (N.J.A.C. 11:15-4.21(e)) **(current FUND members only)**,
3. Direct the FUND to apply the BOARD's share to the FUND's Aggregate Excess Loss Contingency Fund, which provides both current member districts and former member districts with an available individual contingency balance for use in satisfying any possible need for a supplemental assessment for any year they were a member and an annual capacity to use all or a portion of a member district's available balance in offsetting future premiums, **or**
4. Direct the FUND to apportion the BOARD's share as a stated dollar amount among options 1, 2, 3 & 4 above such that the sum total of allocated dollars equals the amount of the Total Distribution available to the BOARD as noted above.

NOW THEREFORE, the BOARD directs the FUND to distribute the BOARD's share of its Net Distribution as follows **(check the one box that applies)**:

9180 SCHOOL VOLUNTEERS

The Board of Education recognizes the services of volunteers can enrich the educational program, assist teaching staff members in the performance of their duties, and enhance the relationship between the school district and the community. The Board authorizes a program for the utilization of volunteer services in the school(s) of the school district.

An unpaid volunteer is not required to complete a criminal history record check. A volunteer is not required to be approved by the Board.

For the purpose of this Policy, a “volunteer” is a person who is not paid by the Board of Education, who assists with classroom or other school activities under the direct supervision of an appropriately certified or licensed school district employee, and provides assistance for school activities on a “regular basis” throughout the school year.

For the purpose of this Policy, “regular basis” means volunteering services more than six occasions during a school year.

For the purpose of this Policy, a “volunteer” is not a person who is invited into a school and provides occasional assistance for school activities, chaperones a class trip, or assists with classroom or other school activities less than six occasions during the school year.

The Superintendent or designee shall determine if a person meets or will meet the requirements to be a “volunteer” for the purpose of this Policy.

~~A volunteer must be approved by the Board upon the recommendation of the Superintendent.~~

The Principal or designee shall be responsible for the recruitment and screening of volunteers, may delegate the assignment of volunteers to specific tasks, and must submit their names for Board approval.

Volunteers must be persons of known character, responsibility, and integrity.

Neither the Superintendent nor any Principal shall be obligated to utilize the proffered services of a volunteer whose abilities or interests do not serve the needs of pupils.

Each school volunteer shall be given a copy of this Policy and the rules of conduct.

The following guidelines shall govern the service of school volunteers:



POLICY

1. Volunteers may serve only under the direction and supervision of an appropriately certified or licensed staff member;
2. Volunteers should clearly understand their duties and responsibilities and perform no service outside those duties;
3. Volunteers serve only in a support capacity; only appropriately certified or licensed staff members are responsible for educational planning and decisions and the teaching of new concepts;
4. Volunteers shall respect the individuality, dignity, and worth of each child;
5. Volunteers are not permitted access to pupil records;
6. Volunteers should exercise discretion in discussing their school activities with others in the community and must maintain confidential any information that if disclosed would violate Federal and State laws;
7. Volunteers may consult with the Principal regarding their duties and responsibilities; and
8. Volunteers shall receive no financial remuneration from the Board.
